Dear Judge Harding;

RE: BRUSH & ASHLEY CREEKS

We are informed that you have made an order taking over the distribution of Brush Creek and Ashley Creek in Uintah Basin and relieving us of this responsibility. As you are aware we have been in the process of adjudicating these two streams for some time and are now nearing completion. From 1959 until 1963, the State Engineer was directed by the Court to administer distribution on these two systems and during this period to assemble data that would make for a more realistic adjudication of the streams. (Civil No. 31974 " " 3315)

In order that the Court may have more background relative to these years of distribution on these two systems, we are sending you a copy of records selected which may assist you in the distribution this coming year.

The State Engineer always stands ready to assist the court in any way he can in the administration and distribution of water. We hope you will feel free to contact us at any time relative to distribution of these systems.

Among the documents we are sending you is the Commissioner's "Report of Distribution of Water Supply". As this is our office copy will you please return it after your inspection. We have already supplied the Court with a copy and do not have any extras.
