To all water users:

We have a request from the users of a majority of the waters of Brush Creek; Uintah County, for supervision of water distribution by the State Engineer for this coming year. It is proposed that a meeting of the Brush Creek water users and the State Engineer be held March 4, 1959 at 1:00 P. M. in the Vernal Courthouse.

This meeting is being called to discuss past water distribution practices and to determine proper distribution procedures for 1959.

It is proposed that at this meeting the following items of business be discussed:

1. Selection of a suitable water commissioner.
2. Adoption of a budget to cover distribution costs for 1959.
3. Determination of a proper assessment to be made against each water user.
4. Method of collecting the assessments.

We suggest all Brush Creek water users be present so that their interests will be properly represented and their recommendations considered.
