

SUMMARY OF MEETING ON SAID & SULPHUR CREEK

A meeting was held May 15, 1978, at the Loa, Utah, courthouse to discuss a distribution schedule for Sand and Sulphur Creek. Those in attendance were:

A discussion was centered around the past distribution and a possible rotation system for 1978. It was agreed by those present that a seven day rotation system would be adopted for 1978 on an interim basis without prejudice to any rights. The turns should start on Wednesday. The results of this method of water division would be reviewed at a meeting prior to next year's irrigation period and changed if necessary.
