RE: TWIN & CEDAR CREEKS.

I am in receipt of your favor of March 16 requesting the appointment of a water commissioner to take charge of the distribution of the waters of Twin and Cedar Creeks.

The law requires the State Engineer, before making such appointment, to afford the water users opportunity of making recommendation as to who shall be appointed, his compensation, and the duties he shall perform. I, therefore, suggest that you and your clients take immediate steps to see that this provision is lived up to.

There has been some difficulty on distribution systems in collecting distribution assessments and it is not right for me to engage a water commissioner unless it is definitely assured that his compensation will be paid promptly and in full.

Your comments and suggestions in regard to the foregoing will be appreciated.
