

Mr. Irvin Snow and Mr. J. W. Blazzard of Farnsworth Canal Company visited the office this morning. They were seeking information about the Equalization plan which was being attempted by the Lake Fork Water Users in Uintah Basin. They said with this plan <sup>as outlined to them by the Committee</sup> their company had not been given credit for some 2500 acre feet of storage capacity ~~and~~ they had <sup>on</sup> Lake Fork System. These reservoirs were built and paid for but they did not fill every year <sup>therefore</sup> ~~and~~ the committee did not see fit to recognize them.

Their stockholders felt they should have credit for reservoir before they could vote to participate in the equalization. Voting would be next week and if they could not convince their people the committee was right or the committee the people were right there would be no getting together. Discussion, advantages and disadvantages of the scheme. Mr. Snow and Mr. Blazzard were to get in touch with the committee again to see just what the plan is now so they could more thoroughly discuss it with their people.
