RE: UINTAH DIST.

I have your letter of June 22 with reference to your distribution troubles and beg to advise you that I have understood that the distribution of these waters was in charge of a Court commissioner.

The law allows the State Engineer to appoint a commissioner for a district but in order to do this there are certain formalities required in the way of consultation with the water users. These requirements are set out in Section 62, Chapter 67, Laws of Utah 1919, copy of which I am sending under separate cover.

With reference to my taking action other than the appointment of a commissioner I would say that unfortunately the office has no appropriation from which it can pay the expense involved.
