
Dear Sir:

I am instructed by the County Commissioners to advise you that, in view of the imminent serious shortage of water for irrigation and domestic purposes in the Uintah Basin during the coming summer, and the fact that the acreage owned by individuals and small irrigation Companies is larger than that of the Indian Service, they consider it very necessary that a Water Commissioner be appointed to look after the distribution of water; and in view of the very satisfactory service given by Mr. Horace W. Sheley in that capacity, they would appreciate his appointment.

Mr. Sheley has also taken an interest in the needs of the people in endeavoring to assist in the efforts being made by our people to secure much needed railroad transportation, without, in any way, neglecting his duties as Water Commissioner, for which reason his retention is particularly desirable at this time.
