Enclosed please find copy of night letter which I have just received from Congressman Colton.

While nothing definite should be done before my conference with Major Post on March 18 I suggest that the Executive Committee give the matter of water commissioner full consideration at once. In other words, assuming that I shall take charge of the distribution, I would like the Executive Committee prepared with a recommendation on those matters covered by the water law, namely, who shall be appointed as commissioner, the compensation he is to receive, and the duties he is to perform.

Under separate cover I am sending you copy of the water law and the particular section covering the appointment of a commissioner is 62 on page 20.
