Dear Mr. Knowlton: REL: BOX ELDER COUNTY WATER RIGHTS

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of April 7, 1939, enclosing a copy of a proposed agreement by and between the State Road Commission and a number of property owners near Brigham City, together with a blueprint showing the location of the present and proposed ditch system used to convey water from the State Road drain to the interested water users.

This agreement has been checked over by Mr. Jerman, who has a knowledge of the facts; he says: "In my judgment it covers the situation very nicely. When the agreement is carried out and the old ditch cemented and the new one constructed, I am sure the water users who have been affected by the draining of land as a result of the road construction will have been taken care of very well. As far as I can see, it appears this should make a very satisfactory arrangement for the irrigators as well as the State Road Commission."
