Dear Sir:

There was received at this office, under date of April 26, 1938, a request of April 21, 1938 signed by Mr. Reynolds V. Reeder, et al. for the division, as between joint owners, of the waters contiguous to the State Road-Brigham-Corinne underpass, as provided in Section 100-5-9, Revised Statutes of Utah, 1933, and acts amendatory thereto. Following this, in accordance with a previous arrangement, Mr. Reid Jerman and Mr. P. H. Sorensen - engineer and Water Commissioner from the State Engineer's office - conferred with you, together with the water users affected at Brigham City on May 4, 1938, where a detailed field examination was made of the lands and waters affected, following which the matter was discussed by these gentlemen with your water users.

After discussing the matter in all particulars, it was finally agreed that by reason of the cost involved and the simplicity of the work, that the water users might themselves appoint one of their number who would act as Water Commissioner, and thus escape the necessity of having the State Engineer appoint a Commissioner; whereupon it was agreed by all parties that the request first above referred to would be withdrawn from the State Engineer's office. So that this might be accomplished, for the purpose of completing the files, I am asking you if you will be kind enough to sign and return the attached request in the self-addressed envelope.
