Dear Mr. Humpherys:

We, the undersigned, joint owners in an irrigation ditch constructed by the State of Utah from its drain near the underpass of North Brigham in Box Elder County, Utah, and running to the lands of the undersigned some distance North of the State Highway, hereby, under provision of Section 100-5-9, Revised Statutes of Utah 1933, request your office to divide the water therefrom in accordance with the rights of the respective parties. This request becomes necessary by reason of the fact that the water ~~course~~ of the land owners have been changed by reason of the construction of said underpass and new State Highway, and the users are unable to properly make the division and distribution of water received through said ditch.

Dated this 21st day of April, 1938.

This petition is signed by approximately 40% of all persons claiming interest and all but one by those who owned ditch prior to change.
