Dear Mr. Hansen:

Reference is made to your letter of May 12, 1973, in which you wish the procedure in placing a commissioner on the Boulder Creek water system.

At present, we do not have a commissioner in your area. However, one can be obtained. The procedure is a meeting with the water users of Boulder Creek in which we would have to:

1. levy an assessment against the water users to pay the cost of the commissioner,
2. determine a method of assessment, and
3. agree on a schedule of water rights.

We have prepared a schedule of rights for your area in the proposed determination. If you people would be agreeable to the use of this schedule, we could put a commissioner on the system in the near future. We would have to work out a cost estimate with you at the meeting which would depend on the amount of service you wish and the mileage necessary for the commissioner to travel.

We hope that this furnishes the information you requested.
