Dear Sir:

Following your advice, I have consulted with Mr. Jerman of your office. May I submit the following information:

The Boulder Irrigation and Water Development Company held a meeting March 16, 1936 at Boulder, Utah. Proper notice having first been given to all parties claiming water in the Boulder Irrigation System. This System is meant to include all water in the Boulder Creek; the east, west, and center Deer Creek, together with the water ~~over~~ Frisky Creek in Garfield County.

Practically all parties owning or claiming water were present at this meeting. By unanimous vote it was decided to employ Franklin Hansen as Water Commissioner, for the Boulder Irrigation and Water <sup>Development</sup> Company; at a salary of \$35.00 per month. The number of months of service needed is to be determined by the Board. The Board was also voted power to make assessments to take care of this expense.

In view of the above, we hereby respectfully ask that you appoint Mr. Franklin Hansen, Water Commissioner, to take care of this work for the current year.
