Dear Mr. McBride,

Boulder

Mr. G. J. Goulding asked me to act in the matter of the proper distribution of the waters of the East Fork of Boulder Creek. I have no authority for such action and am therefore putting the matter up to you. If your authority extends to that section you could either attend to it in person or appoint me as your deputy. As I have some work there in June it would be convenient to act in the matter.

Correspondence in the matter is attached. I made examination of the various weirs the past season. The old weir that divides the main stream to Moosman et-al and to Black, Ormond, Peters and Liston(Haws) was found correct but is very old and needs replacing. However it was doing its work. The new weirs placed by Black and Ormond were found to unduly favor them. Now Haws, otherwise Liston, is placing one. Will likely be incorrect.

If you have no authority in the matter please call it to attention of the State Engineer so that he may either give you jurisdiction or make a separate appointment.
