Dear Sir;

Your letter of December 22 is received:

The desire of the water owners at Boulder is for an Incorporation. As stated before the objects are:

- 1:- To secure a working agreement among the owners of the waters of Boulder Creek and the Deer Creek System. Such agreement to permit of the handling of the affairs of the different companies or persons by one board and one water master.
- 2:- To secure a more or less permanent distribution of appropriated and decreed waters on basis of beneficial use and priority.
- 3:- To arrange for the appropriation of all surplus waters and waters capable of storage to the end that it may be handled by shares for the benefit of the present settlers desiring to increase the productive acreage and for new settlers taking up lands not now under any of the present canal systems.

I am sure that your cooperation will result in a system that will work.
