Dear Sir:

The Salt Lake Tribune states that a water commissioner is to be appointed by your office for the smaller streams of Uintah County.

I hereby submit my name as an applicant for this position.

I have had considerable experience in the measuring and dividing of water, and am acquainted with all the streams that would come under the jurisdiction of this commissioner.

For three seasons(1920-1922) I was in the employ of the Utah experiment Station making a hydrographic survey of Ashley Valley, and during that time took care of the measurement of streams and division of water between the canals according to Court Water Decree No.18, acting as a deputy under Court Water Commissioner, Nile Hughel. During 1923 and 1924, I have made measurements , kept records and took care of Division of water between the Ashley Valley canals.

It would be satisfactory with me to do this work on the per diem basis.
