

MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL WATER USERS MEETING
PRICE RIVER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

Monday, January 30, 1978, 3:30 p.m.

Meeting called to order by Donald Norseth, Water Distribution Engineer,
Division of Water Rights, State of Utah.

Meeting presided over by Dave Rowley, Chairman of the Price River
Distribution System.

Minutes of the last regular annual meeting was read by the Secretary.
There being no corrections or addition the minutes were accepted as read.

Donald Norseth read the financial statement for the year 1977.

Lyle Bryner gave the report on the latest snow survey that he obtained from
the Soil Conservation Service. The report was as follows:

Discussion got back to the budget after the snow survey report.
The Secretary read the application from Dave Rowley and his wife for
the River Commissioner's job for the year 1978. No other applications
were received. They requested a raise of \$1200.00 per year and an
adjustment in the mileage rate on travel (See attached applications).

Motion was made by Jack Chianetta that Dave's application be accepted
as read. Motion seconded by Jack Cottmer. Motion Carried.

The budget items were set up as follows:

1. Commissioner's salary	\$3600.00
2. Matching Social Security Tax	225.00
3. Matching State Retirement	300.00
4. Commissioner's Travel Expense	4000.00
5. Commissioner's Annual Report	250.00
6. Bond & Insurance	50.00
7. Miscellaneous Expenses	250.00
8. Reserve Fund	1000.00
Total	<u>9675.00</u>

Motion made by Sam Fazzio that the budget be \$9675.00 and that the assessments
be made to cover the full budget. Motion seconded by Albert Thayne. Motion
carried.

Considerable discussion was had on the repair and replacement of the gaging station below the Scofield Reservoir. It was reported by John Bene that cost of replacement of the gaging station was at this time prohibitive, and that it was very questionable that the present site would be suitable.

The present method of measuring the discharge from Scofield Reservoir was not satisfactory and subject to excessive errors. It was decided to have new calibrations made on the gate opening early this Spring.

Dave Rowley gave high lights from his report for the year 1977.

Meeting adjourned at 4:15 p.m.

Part II.

Special session was held to discuss the proposed law suit to be filed by Skeen & Skeen in behalf of the Price River Water Users in regard to the changes of stockwatering rights to domestic and other uses on Price River drainage.

After lengthy discussions, it was decided to have Stan Litizzette, Dave Rowley and John Bene meet with Ed Skeen in Salt Lake City to revise the approach and also to change the wording of the document to be filed in the 7th District Court on the matter of changing the stockwatering rights to domestic, culinary and industrial uses. Stan Litizzette was to make the appointment to meet with Mr. Skeen at the earliest possible date.

The attorneys were authorized to represent all of the water users on Price River drainage also, all the cities, irrigation companies, industrial users, livestockmen.


