WATER USERS**

The following application has been filed with the State Engineer to change water in Carbon County throughout the entire year unless otherwise designated. Locations in SLB&M. a-9432 (91-4162) DKD Development Co., A limited Partnership, c-o D.L. Thorup, 3410 W. 3100 S., Salt Lake City, Ut. 84119, propose to change the point of diversion, place, and nature of use of 10.25 ac. ft. of water as evidenced by A-4751 C-601 (91-1962 thru 1966). The water has been diverted from Beaver Creek at a point S. 300 ft. from NW Cor. Sec. 27, T12S, R8E; and used from May 1 to Aug. 31 for the stockwatering of 2,000 sheep, 200 cattle, and 15 horses; and used for the supplemental irrigation of 26.81 acs. in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 22, T12S, R8E.

Hereafter, 10.25 ac. ft. of water is to be diverted from an on-stream reservoir at a point N. 2160 ft. and W. 450 ft. from S $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. Sec. 33, T12S, R8E and stored from Jan. 1 to Dec. 31 by means of an earthfilled dam 13 ft. high creating a reservoir having a 5.1 ac. ft. capacity inundating 2.07 acs. in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 33, T12S, R8E; and used for fish culture; and used from May 1 to Oct. 31 for the stockwatering of 18 cattle in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 33, T12S, R8E.
