

MINUTES OF ANNUAL WATER USERS MEETING

Little Courtroom, Carbon County Courthouse, Price, Utah
Monday, February 2, 1976, 1:00 p.m.

Meeting called to order by Deputy State Engineer John Bene. Meeting turned over to Chairman G. W. Waterman. He asked Donald Norseth, State Water Distribution Engineer, to give a report on what was known to date on the snow survey on the Price River drainage. Mr. Norseth reported that the Scofield Area was 97% of normal but that further south and the Range Creek on Book Cliffs Mountain area were way below normal.

Chairman Waterman asked John Bene, Secretary for the Price River Distribution System, to read the minutes of the last regular meeting. After a brief discussion, Bill Marsing made a motion that the minutes be accepted as read. Motion seconded by Jack Chiaretta. Motion carried.

Lyle Bryner received some late information on the snow survey from the Soil Conservation Service:

White River Area	
Station #1	99% of normal
Station #2	84% of normal
Station #3	65% of normal
Mud Creek	87% of normal
Jones Meadow	107% of normal
Day Valley Divide	91% of normal
Indian Canyon Divide	50% of normal
Ferron Mountain	50% of normal

Donald Norseth gave the financial report on 1975 season's operation after some discussion. Mention was made by the secretary that the state auditor asked about the basis for paying the river commissioner on the mileage deal. The secretary had forgotten about the special conditions outlined in his application for the job. It is all spelled out.

Secretary read Dave and Selma's application for the 1976 season. It was the only application received.

Mr. Rowley gave several highlights on water usage from his annual report. Albert Thayne made the motion that the river commissioner's report be accepted as read. Motion seconded by Boyd Marsing. Motion carried.

Motion made by Boyd Marsing that the following increases be made in the budget:

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Commissioner's salary raised	\$400.00
Matching social security raised	\$ 20.00
Matching state retirement raised	\$ 35.00
Commissioner's travel expense raised	\$200.00
Bonds and insurance raised	\$ 25.00

The total budget was raised \$680.00. The total for the new budget for 1976 is \$6,700.00. The total assessment for 1976 is \$6,700.00. Motion seconded by Lyle Bryner, and motion carried.

Motion made by Bill Marsing that the Rowley application for river commissioner be recommended for appointment. Motion seconded by Sam Fazzio.
