

MINUTES OF THE ADJUDICATION COMMITTEE OF PRICE RIVER IRRIGATION SYSTEM
HELD PRICE CITY CIVIC BUILDING THURSDAY
MARCH 12, 1942, at 9 A.M.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Mr. George Waterman., and it was found that the Carbon , Price, Allred , Wellington, Pioneer No. 1, Pioneer No. 2, Spring Glen Canal, and District Water was represented and the meeting porceeded to transact business.

The minutes of the last Adjudication meeting , held June 20, 1941, was read and approved. The members proceeded to further business.

The Financial Report of 1941 Budget, was read and motion to accept was made by E. E. Pierce, and seconded by Lincoln Marshall and carried.

A motion to adopt some method as in the past to collect assessments was made by E.E. Pierce, and seconded by Charles Larson. Motion passed.

Motion to collect Water Charges or Assessments before delivery of water or May 1st, each year, was made by Lincoln Marshall, seconded by Orson Marsing. Motion passed. (This is also a State Law).

Motion to retain same River Commissioner, Mr. W. J. Blamey, this year as his services were satisfactory the past year. The motion was made by Wilber Burnham, and seconded by E. E. Pierce. Motion carried.

The Chairman, Mr. Waterman, asked the State Engineer, Mr. Ed. H. Watson, regarding the control of all waters on this irrigation project, including waters of Scofield reservoir. The State Engineer, informed Chairman, and water users assembled that it was the duty of the river commissioner,

The Canal Companies should contact river commissioner for all water desired.

Motion was made and passed to adjourn meeting until 9 A.M. March 13, 1942, which will be held at Carbon County Courthouse.
