SPECIAL MEETING OF THE WATER-USERS OF THE PRICE RIVER SYSTEM
Held at the Carbon County Court House,
APRIL 9, 1941 at 8:00 P.M.



GEORGE WATERMAN, Chairman of the Adjudication Committee acted Chairman of the Special Water-users Meeting and called the same to Order.

CARLYLE PACE, Acted as Secretary of said Meeting.

Approximately 50 farmers and water-users were in attendance at said meeting.

Purpose of the meeting was to re-submit the proposition of the 1941 River Budget to the Water-users of the Price River System, and to receive their confirmation of the minutes of a Special Meeting of the Adjudication Committee held March 25, 1941.

Minutes of the Special Meeting of the Adjudication Committee were read to said meeting, and a correction made upon said minutes. It was moved by Orson Marsing seconded by Irvin Gerber that the minutes of the Adjudication Committee be corrected to read that the Salary for the River Commissioner for the season of 1941 be set at \$800.00, with an additional \$50.00 for three different snow surveys to be made during the season, making a total of \$850.00 to be included in the 1941 Budget, this to be corrected instead of \$800.00 as set forth in said Minutes. Question on the motion; the Motion passed by all present with a majority vote.

There was a general discussion by all present upon the matter of the Increase in the Commissioner's Salary for the year 1941 as to that of 1940. The meeting was opened for discussion, after which it was moved by LeRoy Livingston, seconded by Irvin Gerber to vote on the Increase and to submit this matter to the water-users of the Price River System. The matter was discussed at length, applications were considered by the water-users, work and duties of the River Commissioner was also discussed at the meeting.

The Motion was amended to include that the various representatives of the various Ditches vote upon this question by the Stock they represent or upon the pro-rata basis upon which their 1940 River Assessment was based. This amendment was passed by all present to let the various Ditches vote according to their Assessment.

The following vote was recorded as to Ditches;

The motion was whether or not the Salary of the River Commissioner for the season of 1941 should be raised to \$800.00, with an extra amount of \$50.00 to be included in the 1941 Budget for three different snow surveys to be made as determined by the State Engineer and the Adjudication Committee for Price River.

The vote showing that seven Ditches were in favor of the motion; and seven Ditches were against said Motion. But to the satisfaction of the Chairman ~~him~~ and the water-users present the Motion carried upon the basis that the Seven largest Canal Companies controls approximately 80% of the stock and that the said seven Companies pay approximately 80% of the assessment of said Budget set up by the water-users of Price River System.

A report on the Snow Survey made by Lincoln Marshall, and Mr. W. J. Blaney was made to the meeting, and Mr. Marshall advising the water-users that out-look for water, both primary, and storage water-rights was very bright for the season of 1941.

There being no further business to come before said meeting, It was moved and Seconded that said meeting be Adjourned. All in favor.
