SPECIAL MEETING OF THE ADJUDICATION COMMITTEE OF PRICE RIVER SYSTEM:-  
Held at the Price City Hall, March 25, 1941

George Waterman, Chairman, called the Meeting and Presided at the same.

Members present at the meeting were as follows:- George Waterman, George Oman, Orson Marsing, John M. Pace, Lincoln Marshall, Lorenzo Petersen, Ralph P. Anderson.

Mr. Carlyle Pace, acted as Secretary of the Meeting.

The Purpose of this meeting was for the Adjudication Committee of Price River to meet, pass on the various applications, and make recommendations to the State Engineer for the appointment of a River Commissioner for the Year 1941, commencing at a date to be decided upon by said Committee and the State Engineer.

This proposition being discussed at a Water-users meeting held at the Court-house March 18, 1941, and the matter of compensation and recommendation being passed to the Adjudication Committee for further action in this matter.

There was a general discussion held by all present and the following roll call was tabulated relative to the various per-centage of vote for each Ditch to vote. It being understood and this per-centage being based upon the payment of Assessment paid by the various Ditch Companies for the season 1940.

Moved by Irvin Gerber seconded by John M. Pace that a majority of the vote present and that said meeting proceed to vote on the recommendation of a River Commissioner. Question:- All members present in favor.

Mr. Ralph P. Anderson presented a statement to the Committee withdrawing his application as River Commissioner, thanking the Adjudication Committee for their past favors and consideration, and pledged his cooperation for the continuance of the consolidations of the various waters of Price River.

A motion was presented by Irvin Gerber, seconded by Orson Marsing, that the Price River Adjudication Committee go on record thanking Mr. R. P. Anderson for his past service, cooperation and loyal support to the various farmers and Companies in working out their various water problems and for his statements that he would still cooperate in working out the Consolidation of waters on Price River. Question:- All members present voting in favor of the above motion.

Upon the withdrawal of the application of Mr. R. P. Anderson, and statements presented to the Committee by Mr. R. P. Anderson, It was moved by Orson Marsing seconded by Irvin Gerber that the members present representing the Adjudication Committee recommend the appointment of Mr. W. J. Blamey as River Commissioner for the season 1941. Question:- All members present in favor of above Motion.

The compensation to be paid for said services including the measuring snow for three different surveys to be \$800.00, and this is the authority for the State Engineer to include this item in the 1941 Budget and assess on the following bases to said Ditches. (No.)

It was moved by Lincoln Marshall, seconded by George Oman that the Secretary forthwith submit a copy of these minutes to the State Engineer and retain a copy for the files of said Committee..

There being no further business to come before the Committee, Moved and Seconded that said meeting be Adjourned. All in favor.
