RE: Carbon County Country Club Water

On May 20, 1982, I met with David Rowley, Price River Water Commissioner and Tom Paluso, President of the Board of Directors for the Carbon County Country Club to discuss the use of water at the golf course. According to the records of the Price River Water Users Association, the Country Club own 133.547 acre feet of water, and the county allows the Country Club to use 19 shares which they purchased from the Country Club. The Country Club also owns 0.167 cfs of First Class water in the Morse Decree based on the Cook Ditch.

It was agreed that the Country Club would annually need 200 acre feet of water plus the decreed water to irrigate approximately 50 acres of land. Mr. Paluso stated that the Club would lease or purchase enough water annually to provide the 200 shares and no meters would be required on the golf course pumps.

Hopefully this meeting and agreement will put an end to the annual problem that has occurred for the past few years.
