Subject: Gooseberry Diversions

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On Monday, July 12, 1965, a field examination was conducted in the company of Mr. Kirby Bench to observe the diversion of water through the Gooseberry Tunnel.

It was found that the devices, as they are installed, will not serve as the need for accurate measurement as set out by the court decree.

A letter was sent to Cottonwood-Gooseberry Irrigation Company advising them to make needed changes on the weirs.

Measurements were recorded, using the structure as an 8-ft. contracted rectangular weir, as follows:

Upper Weir = 19.00 c.f.s.  
Lower Weir = 16.00 c.f.s.
