SUBJECT: PRICE RIVER

TO: DISTRIBUTION PERSONNEL

FROM: DONALD C. NORSETH

In addition to the usual business, it was proposed that the tributaries to the Price River be brought under organized distribution. During 1962 the cost will be carried by the system with assessments being made against these rights in 1963. It was agreed that someone from this office would assist Mr. Thomas in organizing the system and obtaining control on the diversion.

In addition, \$200.00 was set up in the budget by the water users to provide rental and apply for the purchase of a calculator for Mr. Thomas in 1962. If possible a rental with an option to apply the rent paid against the cost of a new machine would be desirable.

Evaporation information relative to the dam at Scofield was received from Harvey Thomas for our analysis and development of evaporation curve.
