Dear Mr. Criddle:

You will recall that when the Price Canal delegation last met with you at your office the question of the use of the Scofield Dam for water storage exclusively by the Carbon Canal came up.

We are still struggling with the problems of more economic use and conservation of what little water we have in these parching times. And more efficient storage is one of the foremost problems we have to face. The question is repeatedly asked and as yet not logically answered:

Why is Carbon Canal given exclusive use of the Scofield dam for storage while it is being paid for by general taxation? We find that the Fish and Game bureau paid for eight thousand acre feet of storage space- this, of course, we cannot use. The rest of the cost of the dam is being paid for by general county taxation.

Is it not logical and fair to all that insomuch as we are all paying for the dam that we should all be allowed to use it for storage?

We are working on this problem now, trying to simplify our storage and division entanglements. Can you clarify this storage problem? This comes up at our next meeting, and help from you will be appreciated.
