TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This is to advise that the records of this office show that the CARBON WATER CONSERVANCY DISTRICT petitioned the Seventh Judicial District Court, Carbon County, State of Utah, to be organized under the Statutes of the State of Utah and that the Findings of Fact, Order and Decree were filed in said court, January 21, 1943. The first Directors of said organization were appointed by the Judge of the District Court, Price, Utah, filed March 22, 1943.

The District was formed for the purpose of construction of the new Scofield Dam and since that time an ad valorem tax has been assessed yearly on all the property showing on the assessment rolls of this county amounting to approximately .25 mills to defray operation of the organization and the repayment of obligation to the United States. No levy was made in 1959 for the reason of funds on hand.
