Dear Mr. Tracy:

Water users on what is called the Spring Glen Extension Canal have complained to the Board of Directors of the Price River Water Conservation District that they are not receiving their share of water through this extension canal. This extension extends beyond the Spring Glen Canal Company's canal and the extension is not subject to the supervision of the jurisdiction of the Spring Glen Canal Company. The water users, under the extension, are not incorporated and each is on an individual basis.

The Price River Water Conservation District does not attempt to distribute water to the individual water users but only places its water at the heads of the respective canals in Carbon County. The distribution of the district water and to the district flow rights that all the canal companies have is left up to the individual canal companies. Since this extension is not incorporated, and the district has no supervision over the distribution of this water, there is no legal entity to contact other than your office for the equal distribution of the water under the Spring Glen Extension Canal.

The Board of Directors of the Price River Conservation District respectively requests you to appoint a referee to supervise the distribution of the water on this extension canal. The Directors suggest Harvey Thomas who is now the River Commissioner of Price River under the supervision of your office to act as such referee. Some of the water users themselves under this extension are also writing to you and making a like request for the appointment of a referee. This matter is urgent and we would appreciate your giving it immediate attention.
