Dear Sir:-

The Decree in the above entitled cause provides as follows:-

"It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed, that said Commissioner shall be appointed by this Court on the First Day of the April Term of the District Court, at Provo City, Utah County, Utah. He shall hold his office for the term of one year and until his successor shall have been appointed and qualified.

Said Commissioner shall receive such compensation as shall be fixed by the Court, at the time of his appointment, payable in quarterly installments by the Clerk of this Court from moneys deposited by the parties for that purpose, as hereinafter provided (Paragraph -127-, page 76 of Decree.)

Under the foregoing provisions and the Decree, I hereby make application for re-appointment as said Commissioner for the ensuing term, at the present salary of Three Thousand Dollars per annum together with reasonable allowance for office rent, stationary, postage, telephone service, and actual and necessary traveling expenses, payable as provided in said decree.
