ASSIGNMENT OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER RIGHT.

Know all men by these presents:

That I, Charles F. Decker, of Provo City, Utah County, Utah, in consideration of the payment to me of the sum of One Dollar, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, by Provo City, A Municipal Corporation, of Utah County, Utah, have sold, assigned, transferred and set over, and by these presents do hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the said Provo City, a Municipal Corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, all my right, title, interest, possession, claim and demand whatsoever, which I may have or possess of, in and to the use of any part of the waters of Provo River, by virtue of a notice of appropriation of the said water, the said appropriation having been made under and by virtue of the provisions of Chapter 100 of the Session Laws of the Legislature of the State of Utah, 1903, the amount of water covered by said appropriation being 100 second feet, to be diverted by means of a dam and headgates at a point just below the tail race of the Telluride Power Plant near the mouth of Provo Canyon, Utah County, Utah, and to be conveyed thence through a flume about 12000 feet to where the water will be used from January 1 to December 31 of each and every year for developing power to be used for lighting purposes and propelling machinery at Provo City: the water so used to be turned into City Creek and a portion back into the natural channel of Provo River at a point about one half mile in southerly direction from the northwest corner of Sec 19, T. 6. S. R. 3 E. S. L. *mu*. The notice of said appropriation as published by the State Engineer is dated Salt Lake City, Utah Apr 16, 1904, and the same was published in the Enquirer, a newspaper published at Provo City, Utah, from the 16th day of April to the 16th day of May, both inclusive, 1904. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this first day of July, 1904, at Provo City, Utah County, State of Utah.
