The West Union Canal Company, one of the defendants herein, having filed through its duly authorized agents a petition in the above entitled cause setting forth and alleging the necessity of having the waters between it and a voluntary association known as the Smith Ditch Company, which said petition is hereby referred to and made a part of this order, and it now appearing to the above entitled court that it is necessary that the waters between the said Smith Ditch Company and the petitioner herein, the West Union Canal Company, a corporation, be divided; and it also appearing to this Court that it is necessary that an order to show cause now issue from said Court requiring all the parties interested to be and appear before the said Court at the Court Room thereof upon a certain day to show cause, if any they or either of them have, why the said division of said waters should not be made, and to further show cause, if any they or either of them have, why the costs of said division should not be assessed against one or more of said parties:
