In the above entitled cause the petition of James Stewart, coming on regularly for hearing this 24th day of April, 1922, before the Court sitting without a jury, said petitioner being represented by the firm of Hatch & Porter, Lawyers, and the other parties to said above entitled cause, who are interested in the Provo Division of said Provo River, being represented by their respective counsel, and it appearing from the records and files herein that said petition was regularly noticed for hearing, and there being no protest or objection to said petition being filed, and the Court having heard the evidence and examined the proofs offered by petitioner, and having heretofore filed its supplemental findings of fact and conclusions of law herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with said findings of fact and conclusions of law, it is hereby ordered, adjudged and decreed that the said petitioner be, and he is hereby awarded of the waters of Provo River in what are designated in the decree in the above entitled cause as Class "A" rights in the Provo Division, waters for 8.20 acres of farm land, as follows:

From May 10th to June 20th, Duty 57, 0.144 second feet
" June 20th to July 20th, Duty 63, 0.130 " "
" July 20th to May 10th, " 70, 0.117 " "

and it is hereby further ordered that said petitioner, James Stewart, his successors and assigns be and they are hereby bound by all of the other provisions of the decree in said above entitled
