To The Honorable Mayor and City Council,
Provo City,

Gentlemen :- Since our Committee were requested to submit to you for your Consideration the amount of damage done us by your pipe line, as discussed by both committees on the ditch Saturday 13th. Inst.; we submit the following propositions for settlement:

Where your pipe is exposed to the ditch we wish it moved back far enough that it will not be an obstruction, and also wish sufficient remuneration to enable us to properly repair the bottom of our ditch which has been made to leak by the construction of your pipe line, which we estimate at \$100.00.

Or if you do not wish to settle on these terms we will ask you to properly repair the ditch under our supervision and instruction, to our satisfaction.


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That, whereas, the undersigned THE BLUE CLIFF CANAL COMPANY, a corporation, is the owner of a certain canal leading from Provo River, in Utah County, Utah, and alleges that Provo City had damaged its said canal; and

Whereas, said Provo City has repaired said canal to the acceptance of the undersigned company and to its entire satisfaction,--

NOW THEREFORE, for and consideration of the work of repair of said canal by Provo City, and the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, lawful money of the United States to it in hands paid by the said Provo City, the said The Blue Cliff Canal Company, a corporation, does hereby, for itself, its successors and assigns, hereby release and forever discharge the said Provo City from all and all manner of claims, demands, causes of action and matters and things, whether in law or in equity, heretofore occasioned, caused or brought about by the injury to the said Blue Cliff Canal Company's canal or other property, and particularly including any injury or damage heretofore occasioned, caused or brought about by the city, or its employes, or special contractors in laying or constructing any pipe line in Provo Canyon. And the said The Blue Cliff Canal Company does hereby accept the repairs made by the City to its said canal as final and complete.

In witness whereof the said Blue Cliff Canal Company has hereunto caused its corporate name to be subscribed and its seal to be affixed on this 10th. day of April, A.D., 1909, by its president and secretary, thereunto duly authorized by resolution of its board of directors heretofore adopted.
