Now come the said plaintiff and Hyrum Heiselt, one of the defendants, and mutually enter in this voluntary stipulation, as follows, to-wit;

X That, whereas, there are certain springs of water arising on and flowing in the land of the parties of this stipulation between Springdell and the mouth of Provo canyon, on the northwest side of Provo River, which waters many years have been used exclusively on the said lands, X it is therefore stipulated that the waters of the East Spring on the lands of the plaintiff known as the Steele farm, shall be equally divided between parties of this stipulation.

That all the other waters arising on or flowing through the said Steele farm, and the use thereof, shall belong solely to the said plaintiff.

That all the waters arising on or flowing through the lands of the said defendant, Hyrum Heiselt, from the springs, except as hereinafter stated, shall belong solely to the said defendant, Hyrum Heiselt. Also two minute feet of Class A water from Provo River, to be taken out of the Provo Reservoir Company's Canal, near the headgate thereof, under the direction of the Water Commissioner for Provo River.

That the East Spring arising on the said land of the defendant, Hyrum Heiselt, known as the Maple Spring, shall belong solely to the said plaintiff, together with all spring water heretofore running in the Blue Cliffs Canal above said Maple Spring.

This stipulation is not intended to affect any rights which may belong to parties other than the two entering into this stipulation.

That this stipulation may be filed, entered of record and made a part of the case hereinabove entitled.
