

WARRANTY DEED

PROVO RESERVOIR COMPANY, a corporation, Grantor, by Joseph R. Murdock, its President, with its principal place of business at Provo City, in the County of Utah, State of Utah, hereby conveys and warrants to the Town of Orem, a municipal corporation, Grantee, of Utah County, State of Utah, for the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), the following described water in Utah County, State of Utah, to-wit:

All of those certain springs lying North of the canal of the Blue Cliffs Canal Company which are situated on the tract of land particularly described in a certain deed from Susannah M. Steele and Leandro Steele, her husband, to the Blue Cliffs Canal Company, a corporation, and recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Utah County, State of Utah, in Book 102 at Page 403, excepting a one-half interest in the eastern-most spring located on said tract of land; which said one-half interest in said spring not hereby conveyed, is owned by Hyrum Heiselt.

Also, the right to develop and improve the said springs and collect the water therefrom, together, and to construct and use such canals, ditches, pipe lines and other means of conserving and conveying said water from said springs over and across the land described in said deed.

This instrument is made pursuant to a resolution of the Board of Directors of said corporation, Grantor, duly passed by them, authorizing the President to execute, acknowledge and deliver the same.
