CONTEMPT PROCEEDING

Motion to Require Plaintiff

to make Purported Amended
Affidavit more Definite and
Certain.

Come now the defendants in the above entitled cause and without waiving in any manner their motion heretofore made and filed herein moving the Court to strike the purported amended affidavit of R.J.Murdock herein, and said defendants hereby move this Court to require said plaintiff to make said purported amended affidavit of said R.J.Murdock, purporting to have been made and filed herein on the 12th day of July, 1927, more definite and certain in the following particulars, to-wit:

That this Court require said plaintiff to state definitely when the defendants, or either of them, at any time, or times, prior ^{to} or since the first day of February, 1924, in wilful disregard of the decree and injunction in the above entitled cause, and in wilful contempt of the same, and in wilful disregard of the rights of the plaintiff herein, by means of excavations and the collection of any waters of any springs into any pipe lines, or otherwise, violated any of the provisions of the decree in this cause; and,

That this Court require the plaintiff to state de-

finitely the place, or places on, prior, or since, the first day of February 1924, the defendants, or either of them, in wilful disregard of the decree and injunction in the above entitled cause, or in wilful contempt of the same, or in wilful disregard of the rights of the plaintiff herein, by means of excavations and the collection of the waters of any springs into pipe lines, or otherwise, in any manner violated the provisions of the decree in this cause.
