Dear Ed:

Thank you for your submittal of ground-water use and water quality data. Salt Lake City Corporation is always timely in the submittal of data, and we greatly appreciate it. We did not, however, receive a **1993** water quality analysis for several of your wells which had withdrawals of greater than 250 acre-feet in 1993. Our records indicated analysis were not received for the following wells:

1. Well #1655 5900 S. 1800 E. -----427 AF
2. Well 1651A 6475 S. 2650 E. -----370 AF
3. Well #1654 1794 VTL Green -----250 AF
4. Well #1061A 1511 E. 500 S. -----692 AF
5. Well #1056A 202 Canyon Rd. -----725 AF

As you are aware, the Salt Lake Valley Interim Ground-Water Management Plan requires a limited inorganic analysis for all wells that pump over 250 acre-feet per year. We would appreciate a sample could be taken from these wells in 1994, in addition to the wells you sampled in 1993.

Would it also be possible to get a copy of the actual lab results for each analysis run, in addition to the electronic form you are currently sending us? We need to keep track of comments made by the lab regarding the analysis, as well as the sample date. Since we do not have sample dates for the 1992 and 1993 data you submitted, it would be very helpful if you could send us the sample dates for these analysis. We are not entering data into our database for years prior to 1992, therefore, it is not necessary to send us data gathered prior to that time.

Once again, I want to thank you for your cooperation in this matter. We will be sending out an "Update Report" to water users next month summarizing recent work, and the current status of the Interim Ground-water Management Plan.
