S T I P U L A T I O N .

* * * * *

1. That whereas the above entitled action has been brought to determine and adjudicate and decree the rights of all the users and claimants of the waters of Provo River and its tributaries and for the purpose of stipulating the acreage and the rights to the waters of said Provo River of the parties defendants hereto and to avoid the expense of offering proof in open court, it is hereby agreed as follows, to-wit:

2. That Hyrum S. Winterton is the owner of 20.50 acres of land; that William L. Van Wagoner is the owner of 9.70 acres of land situated in Section 2 and Section 11, Township 4 South of Range 4 East, Salt Lake Meridian in Wasatch County, Utah; that said defendants are entitled to a first class water right to said lands to irrigate the same.

3. That the only source of water supply available to water said lands is from springs and seepage water arising and coming into the bed of Snake Creek on the land now owned by George Price in Section 3, Township 4 South of Range 4 East, Salt Lake Meridian, and that the amount arising and flowing in said Snake Creek channel varies in its quantity from time to time. The amount varying from one-half second foot to one second foot of natural flow of springs and seepage water.

4. For the reasons above set forth it is hereby agreed and stipulated that the defendants Hyrum S. Winterton and Wm. L. Van Wagoner shall have decreed to them, for the lands above described, all of the waters, not to exceed one second foot, arising in the bed of Snake Creek, by springs, seepage, etc., on the George Price farm in Section 3, Township 4 South of Range 4 East, Salt Lake Meridian

aforesaid.
