PETITION OF T.F.WENTZ. COMMISSIONER.

Comes now T.F.Wentz, the Commissioner heretofore appointed by this court in the above entitled cause, and respectfully shows:

That he has served as such Commissioner during the years 1915 and 1916 as provided in the Courts order of April 2, 1915, and February 29, 1916.

That in addition to the prescribed work of regulating and distributing the waters of Provo River, at the request of parties to this cause, he collected data and formulated a stipulation for the settlement of the water rights in Wasatch and Summit Counties.

That the stipulation filed and accepted by the parties in Wasatch and Summit Counties embodies the material elements of the stipulation drawn by T.F.Wentz.

That, he was engaged in this work December 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13, 15, 16, 17, 18, and 24, in the year 1915, and January 5, 15, and 22, in the year 1916, and at divers times in January, February and March 1916.

That, he has not made a claim, heretofore, to the parties in this cause for compensation for this work, and that, he has not received payment for the whole or any part thereof.

That, the value of this service is \$150.00.

That, upon his information and belief he states that the stipulation referred to has been the means of a great saving to all the parties to this cause, and that the amount claimed is justly due.

WHEREFORE, your Commissioner prays, that an order be made in open court directing the parties to pay this amount in the same manner as provided in the Courts order of April 2nd, 1915.


