
As provided in paragraph -128- of the Decree in the above entitled Cause, the Commissioner T.F.Wentz, on the 1st day of April, 1941, reccomended and submitted for the approval of the Court the following:

That, I.F.Baum, of Heber, Wasatch County, Utah, be employed as an assistant to the commissioner, to regulate and distribute the waters of Provo River in the Second and Third Districts of the Wasatch Division, and to regulate and distribute the waters from the Weber-Provo Diversion Canal to the owners of the same in Wasatch County, Utah, and to pass of the same from said Diversion Canal by Midway Lower Dam to the owners of the same in Utah County, Utah; for the term of one year, and until his successor shall have been employed, and for such service to be paid the sum of \$750.00 per annum together with allowance for telephone service.

The Court approved the same on the _____ day of April, 1941.

On account of the drought, the additional work required by passing waters to the Deer Creek Reservoir, and the patrolling of the river daily, the Commissioner T.F.Wentz now reccomends and submits for the approval of the Court, that, the salary of I.F.Baum, of Heber, Wasatch County, Utah, an assistant to the Commissioner be for the season of 1941, the sum of \$1000.00.
