
The attached pages contain the 2012 Annual Report for the Beryl Enterprise Distribution System.

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**Beryl/Enterprise Water Distribution System
Minutes of the 2012 Annual Meeting on February 21, 2012
Escalante Valley Community Center, Beryl Junction, Utah**

The meeting was convened at 1:00 P.M. by Mike Brown, Chairman.

The minutes of the 2011 Annual Meeting were passed out to the members and reviewed. Steve Christensen made a motion to dispense with the reading of the minutes and to accept the minutes as written. Howard Bracken seconded the motion. The motion passed.

The 2011 Annual Commissioner's Report was presented by Todd Terry. A copy of the report was passed out to every member to review. Todd reported that there were a few delinquent accounts this past year but they are in the process of being resolved. The new aerial maps and spread sheets were presented and reviewed by those who were in attendance. Todd also brought up his concern of upgrading the computer software and hardware. Motion to accept the commissioner's report was made by Mason Jones and seconded the Nyal Bosshardt. The motion passed.

Some concerns of the spread sheet were discussed and Kurt Vest from the office of the Division of Water Rights, suggested that a legend be added to the spread sheets for clarification of color coding.

Mike Silva suggested that the lines of communication be kept open with Water Commissioner, Todd Terry. The water users need to be more diligent in reporting their use of crops that use less water than alfalfa.

Jared Manning, from the Division of Water Rights, introduced himself and stated that he has filled the position, which was left vacant by the retirement of Lee Sims. He presented the 2011 Financial Report. A motion was made to accept the Financial Report by Craig Laub and Seconded by Steven Jones. The Motion Passed.

Discussion on 2012 budget: Chairman, Mike Brown, proposed that Todd Terry receive an increase in his salary from \$12,000 to \$13,000 yearly. Motion to accept the increase and to approve the 2012 budget was made by Craig Laub. Seconded by Nyal Bosshardt and the motion passed.

The 2012 Annual Water Users Assessment was discussed and it was agreed to increase from \$16,877.00 to \$17,000. A motion was made to accept the Assessment by Nyal Bosshardt, seconded by Craig Laub, and the motion passed.

Mike Brown reviewed the current board member positions and opened the floor for nominations of board members. A motion was made to suspend the rules and re elect the current board member by Nyal Bosshardt, seconded by Robert Holt, and the motion passed.

The meeting adjourned at 2:15 P.M.

2012 Commissioner Report

1. This year I spent a fair amount of time mapping in crop types. As we track crop types it will help us be more aware of water savings for the new Ground Water Management Plan. I hope everyone takes a look at the maps to see if I listed your fields and crop types correctly.
2. I removed the tags from the Pinto diversions in April and put them back on in November.
3. I would like to thank all those who paid their water assessment this year. I sent out a notice around September to anyone who was late in an attempt to alleviate anyone showing up on the delinquent list.
4. Due to a very dry winter Newcastle reservoir filled to within 6 feet of top but did not overflow. Enterprise reservoir upper and lower did not overflow and was estimated to be at 58% capacity.
5. The state engineer passed on our new ground water management plan and it went into effect on 21 Dec 2012. More information is on the Division of Water Rights Website.
6. The Beryl Enterprise system purchased a new computer this year and updated the mapping software to the current version.
7. The State Division of Water Rights purchased new plotters for their departments in 2012. This created a surplus plotter which was offered to the Beryl Enterprise Distribution area. I told them we would welcome a plotter in our area so we now have a plotter that can print large format maps in Enterprise.

Beryl Enterprise Groundwater Management Plan

Adoption Date: December 21, 2012

Introduction

This document presents the State Engineer's groundwater management plan for the Beryl Enterprise area. The objectives of this groundwater management plan are to limit the groundwater withdrawals to safe yield, protect the physical integrity of the aquifer, and protect water quality. The intent of this plan is to provide specific management guidelines for this area under the statutory provisions within Section 73-5-15 of the Utah Code.

For the purposes of this plan, the Beryl Enterprise area consists of the area, which physically drains to the Utah portion of the Beryl Enterprise Groundwater basin as, illustrated in Figure 1.

The safe yield for the groundwater basin has been determined to be approximately 34,000 acre-feet per year. The current average depletion from the groundwater system is estimated at approximately 65,000 acre-feet per year. The total reduction needed to return the withdrawals to safe yield is estimated as 31,000 acre-feet per year of depletion. The groundwater withdrawals in this area have for over 40 years consistently exceeded the safe yield of the aquifer making this a critical management area as defined in section 73-5-15 of the Utah Code.

Water Regulation

The regulation schedule to reduce the depletion is displayed in Table 1. The schedule is a gradual implementation approach, authorized by statute for critical management areas, which consists of two phases. The first phase reduces the total depletion by 10% at the end of an approximate 40-year period. The second phase reduces the depletion by an additional 5% at the end of 10-year periods until the target reduction of 31,000 acre-feet is achieved or evidence indicates that additional reductions are not necessary.

The regulated reductions required by this plan shall be implemented by priority date of the water rights regardless of the nature of use (i.e. Irrigation, Stockwatering, Municipal, Domestic, Mining, or Other). The State Engineer will maintain a priority list on the Division of Water Rights website which reflects depletion by water right for purposes of this groundwater management plan. Water rights that are non-consumptive will be excluded from the priority regulation schedule and will not be required to be reduced. Water use where no water right has been established or is in violation of an existing water right will be subject to enforcement action under State Code 73-2-25.

Depletion Calculations

For purposes of the groundwater management plan annual depletions from irrigation will be calculated using an annual crop survey prepared by the distribution system commissioner. The crop survey will tabulate irrigated acres for every crop type in the management plan boundary. It will include acreage supplied by both surface and underground sources. The crop survey will be published every year in the "Beryl Enterprise Water Distribution System Annual Water Report." The total depletion from irrigation will be calculated by multiplying the number of acres of crops irrigated by the estimated crop consumptive use values from the *Enterprise/Beryl Junc. Station* published in "Consumptive Use of Irrigated Crops in Utah, Research Report 145." The State Engineer will consider the use of scientifically verified studies that provide more accurate crop consumptive use values. Any reduction in use by either a decrease in acres or through the irrigation of less consumptive crops will be accounted for as a reduction from the total depletion. The baseline for irrigation from which future reductions will be calculated is the amount of irrigation from 2012, 29,278 acres, multiplied by the consumptive use value for alfalfa, 2.4925 feet, which equals 72,975 acre-feet. This baseline accounts for acreage supplied by both surface and underground sources.

If there are reductions in irrigation because water use is changed to new use through the application process, then the baseline for irrigation will be adjusted to reflect the decrease in irrigation rather than the decrease in depletion. If a decrease in depletion from the system results from the change application then this decrease will be accounted for by the State Engineer. Accounting procedures adopted under this plan for decreasing the irrigation depletion by growing less water consumptive crops may not be construed to authorize acreage to be expanded under a water right. The procedures are applicable only as a groundwater management tool in the Beryl Enterprise basin.

Depletions from uses other than irrigation will be computed on the basis of standard practices by the State Engineer and supplemented by actual reporting provided by the water right holder. The

standard values are as follows: Stockwatering, 0.028 acre-feet per Equivalent Livestock unit; Domestic Use, 0.09 acre-feet per Equivalent Domestic Unit; Industrial, Commercial, Recreational, Municipal, and Mining uses will be evaluated on an individual basis. Depletion reductions achieved from uses other than irrigation reported to the Division of Water Rights will be considered along with those accounted under change applications.

An estimate of the total depletion, the amount of reductions achieved, and any modification to the baseline amount of irrigation will be published each year in the “Beryl Enterprise Water Distribution System Annual Water Report.”

Adaptive Management

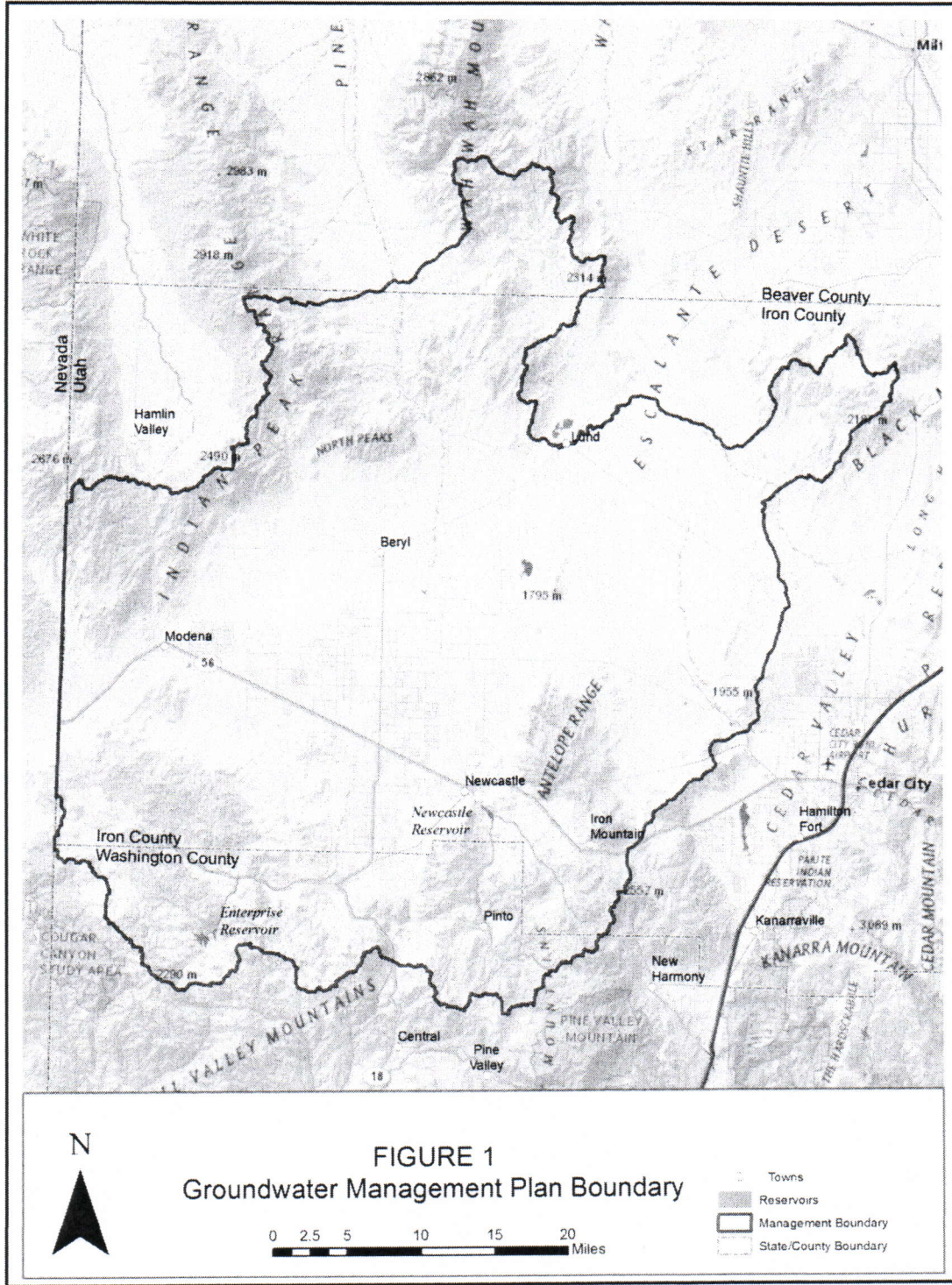
The plan’s objective is to reduce the depletion from the system to the safe yield of the aquifer. To determine the effectiveness of the plan water level measurements will be used. As withdrawals approach safe yield it is anticipated that groundwater levels will stabilize without further decline. The stepped reductions in depletions over long intervals as specified in the management plan are intended to provide an opportunity for measured water level response to the changes in groundwater pumping. A reduction in the rate of groundwater level decline over time will be used as an indicator of approaching equilibrium of recharge versus withdrawal from the groundwater system. If during any phase of the plan it is determined that safe yield has been reached, future reductions will not be implemented. This plan may also be amended at any time in the same manner it was adopted.

Voluntary Arrangements

In consultation with the State Engineer, water users may agree to participate in a voluntary arrangement to manage withdrawals based on a system other than priority date. Table 1 specifies the amount and schedule of the reductions to be met. If a voluntary arrangement is successful in accomplishing required reductions within the timeframe specified in Table 1, the State Engineer will not order reductions in use based on priority date.

Change Application Considerations

There is a current policy that change applications proposing to move groundwater rights to the district titled the “Heavily Pumped” area will be denied. As part of this management plan this policy restriction will be eliminated. Thus change applications proposing to move groundwater rights anywhere within the management plan boundary will be reviewed on their individual merits and may be approved.



Groundwater Management Plan Update

This is a report to publish the baseline amount of irrigation, the annual depletions, and the amount of depletion reductions achieved each year for the Beryl Enterprise Groundwater Management Plan adopted 12/21/2012.

Original Baseline Irrigation:

The Beryl Enterprise Groundwater Management Plan set the original baseline irrigation value as the total amount of acres irrigated in 2012.

Total Acres:	29,278 acres
Net Irr. Depletion Factor:	2.4925 acre-feet/acre
Total Depletion:	72,975 acre-feet

Modifications to the Baseline Irrigation:

Modifications to the baseline are reported and tabulated on an annual basis as follows:

2012 Modification - Reduction of 282 acres

The total number of irrigated acres at the time of adoption of the plan was reported as 29,278 acres. Since the plan was adopted the actual amount of irrigated acres in 2012 was later adjusted to be 28,996 acres in the annual report. This adjustment was because of improvements made in mapping, accounting procedures, and from the removal of the accounting of acreage supplied by "high water". The baseline will be modified to account for these refinements. The baseline now represents the actual amount of irrigated acreage in 2012.

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Escalante Valley

Beryl-Enterprise Area

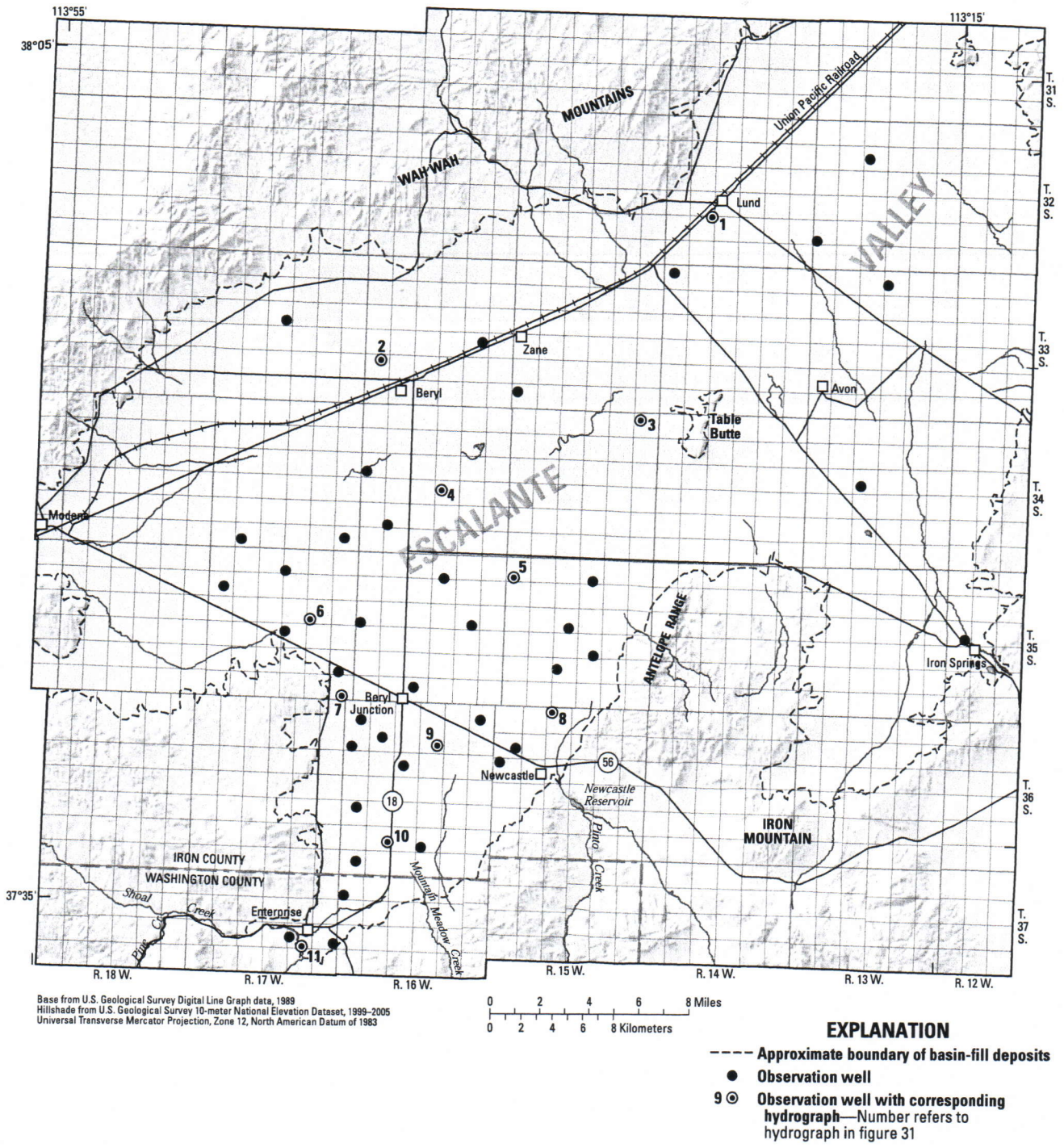


Figure 30. Location of wells in the Beryl-Enterprise area in which the water level was measured during March 2012.

The Beryl-Enterprise area covers about 800 square miles at the southern end of Escalante Valley, southeast of the Wah Wah Mountains in Iron County, and a small area in Washington County in the vicinity of the community of Enterprise (fig. 30). Groundwater occurs in unconsolidated basin-fill deposits in the valley.

Total estimated withdrawal of water from wells in the Beryl-Enterprise area in 2011 was about 84,000 acre-feet, which is 6,000 acre-feet less than in 2010 and 5,000 acre-feet less than the average annual withdrawal for 2001–2010 (tables 2 and 3).

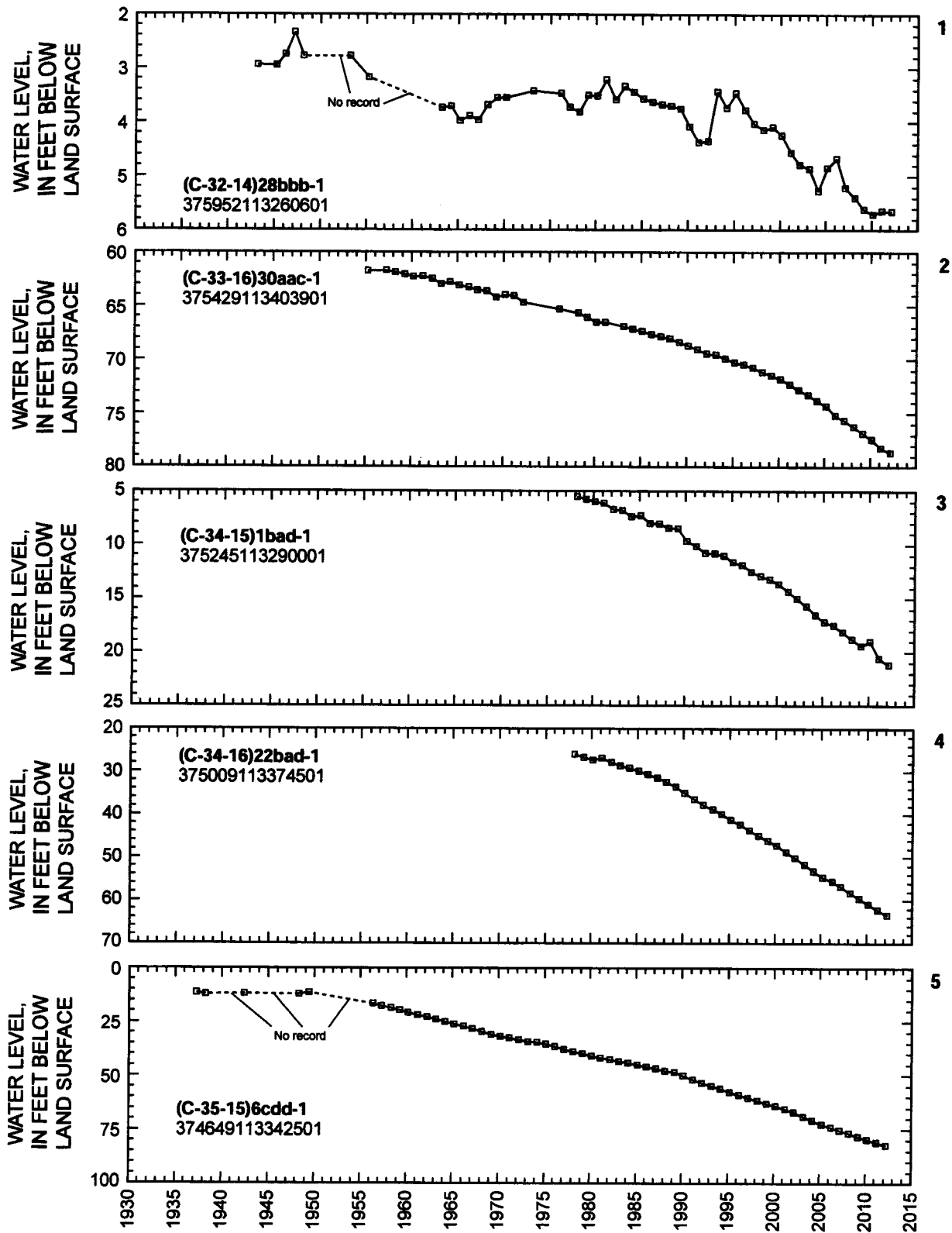


Figure 31. Relation of water level in selected wells in the Beryl-Enterprise area to cumulative departure from average annual precipitation at Enterprise, to annual withdrawal from wells, and to concentration of dissolved solids in water from well (C-34-16)28dcc-2.

The location of wells in the Beryl-Enterprise area in which the water level was measured during March 2012 is shown in figure 30. The relation of the water level in selected observation wells to cumulative departure from average annual precipitation at Enterprise, to annual withdrawal from wells, and to concentration of dissolved solids in water from well (C-34-16)28dcc-2 is shown in figure 31.

Precipitation at Enterprise in 2011 was about 11.5 inches, which is about 2.6 inches less than the average annual precipitation for 1955–2011 and about 13.8 inches less than in 2010.

Water levels declined slightly from March 2011 to March 2012 in most of the wells measured in the Beryl-Enterprise

area. Water levels have declined steadily since 1950 and show little or no recovery during periods of greater-than-average precipitation. The declines are a result of continued large withdrawals for irrigation since 1950. A decline of about 130 feet from March 1946 to March 2012 was measured in well (C-36-16)29daa-1, about 5 miles northeast of Enterprise (fig. 31).

The concentration of dissolved solids in water samples collected from well (C-34-16)28dcc-2, located 6 miles south-southeast of Beryl, from 1950 to 2011, is shown in figure 31. Based on the chemistry of the water from this well, the sum of the constituents has been determined to be the best method to estimate the concentration of dissolved solids. The concentration has ranged from 460 to 699 mg/L with a median value of 649 mg/L. The concentration of dissolved solids in the water sample collected in August 2011 was 681 mg/L.

Physical properties and results of chemical analyses for water from four wells in the Beryl-Enterprise area are shown in tables 5 and 6, and the locations of the wells are plotted in figure 41. The concentration of dissolved solids in the water sample from well (C-34-16)28dcc-2 exceeded the secondary drinking-water standard (500 mg/L).

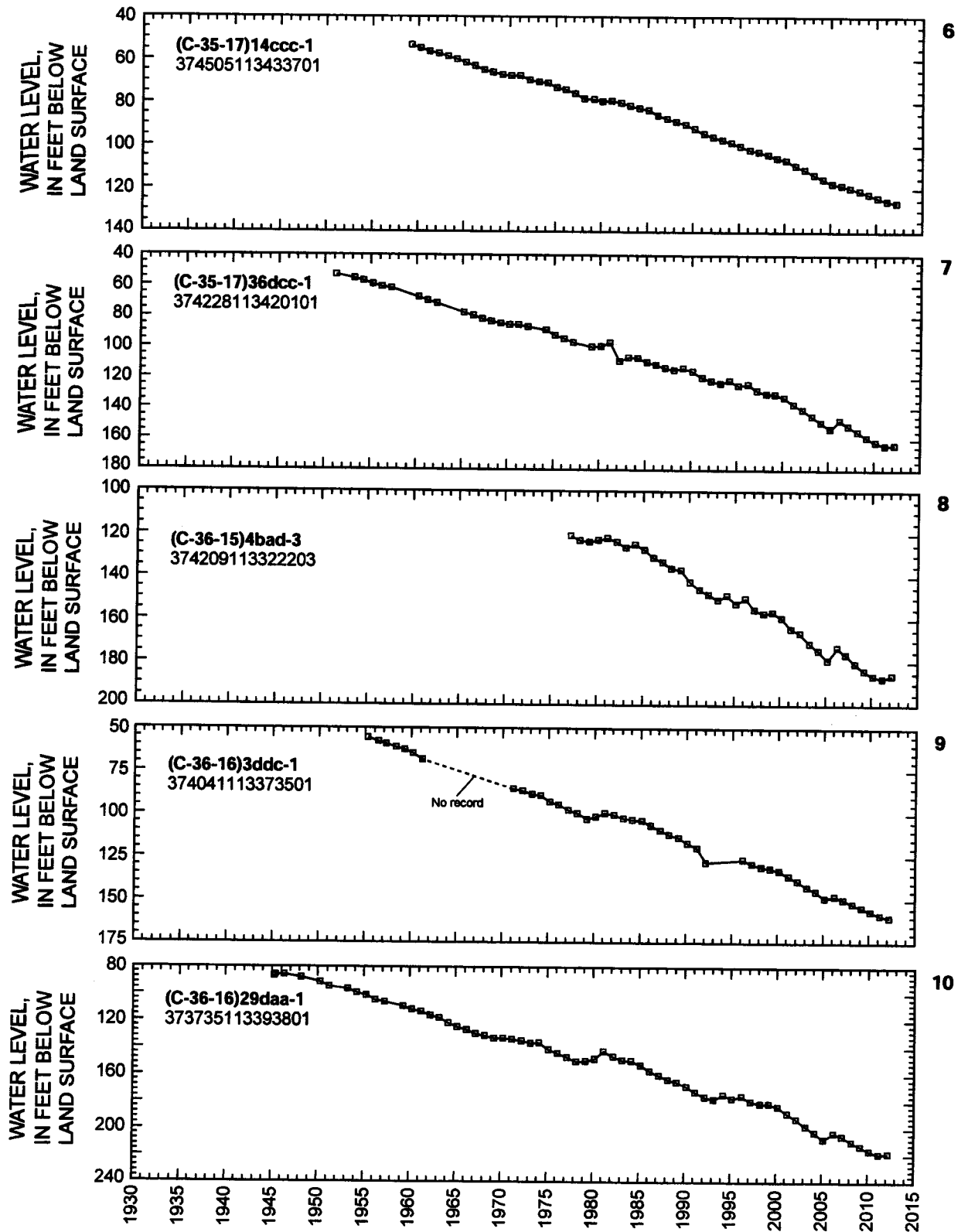


Figure 31. Relation of water level in selected wells in the Beryl-Enterprise area to cumulative departure from average annual precipitation at Enterprise, to annual withdrawal from wells, and to concentration of dissolved solids in water from well (C-34-16)28dcc-2.—Continued

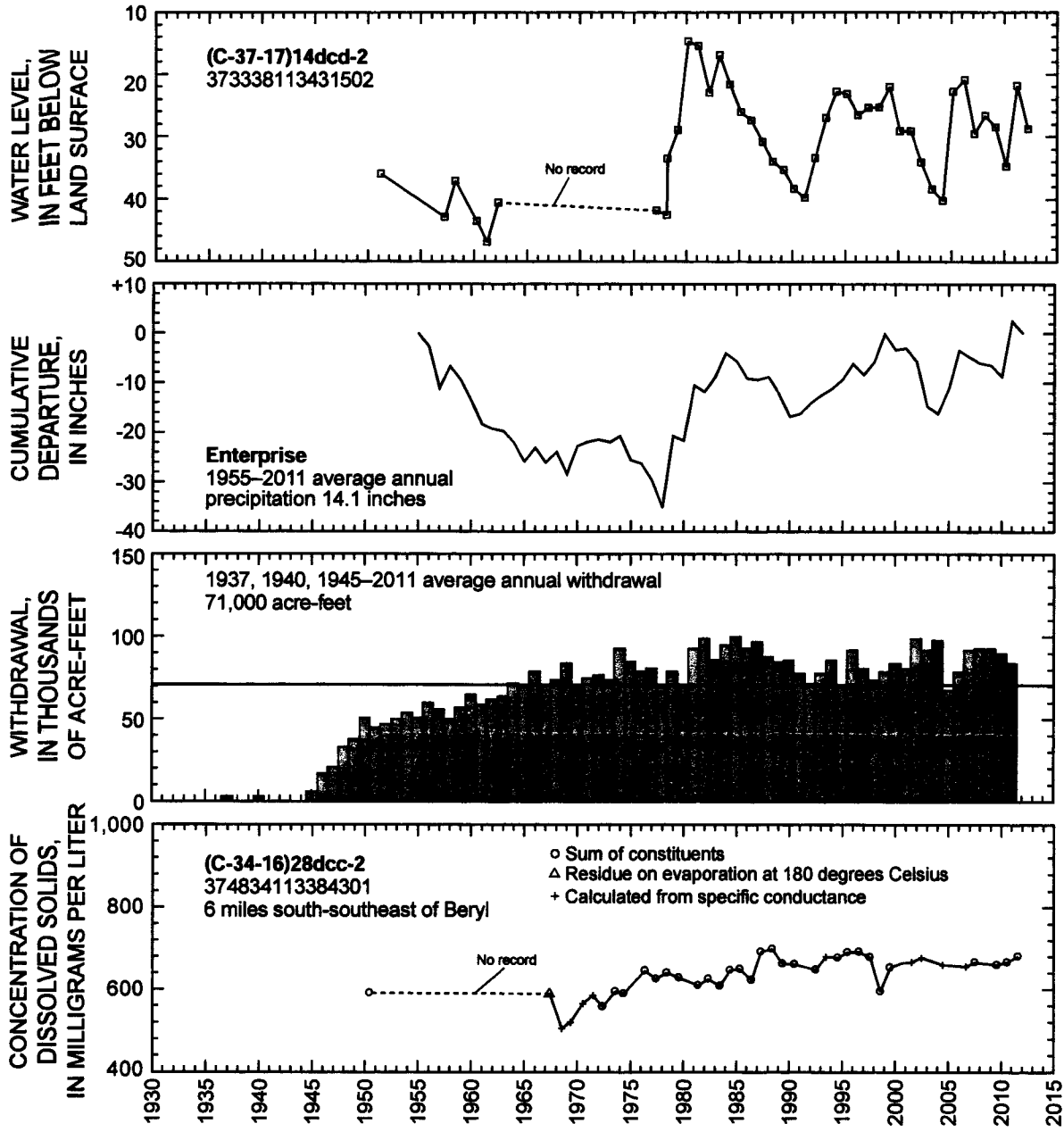


Figure 31. Relation of water level in selected wells in the Beryl-Enterprise area to cumulative departure from average annual precipitation at Enterprise, to annual withdrawal from wells, and to concentration of dissolved solids in water from well (C-34-16)28dcc-2.—Continued
