Dear Mayor Paice:

At approximately 12:30 P.M. on this date, I received a complaint whereby Mr. Lindsay, manager of the golf course, had diverted the water from the canal into the pond. This is in violation of an agreement between the lion's Club, Beaver City and Henry Woods whereby, during Beaver City's water turn in the Willis Canal, Mr. Woods would irrigate the trees and lawns around the race track area. Any surplus water or time beyond that which was needed to irrigate the trees and grass, Mr. Woods was to use this water on his own properties. This has been in effect for the last fifteen years.

Please be advised that if Mr. Lindsay interferes with the distribution of these waters without permission of Mr. Woods it will necessitate the filing of charges against Mr. Lindsay. I hope that this will not be necessary and that Mr. Lindsay will not interfere with these waters again.
