INTERLOCUTORY ORDER FIXING
LIMITATIONS ON WITHDRAWAL
OF UNDERGROUND WATER FOR THE
YEAR 1962 AND FUTURE YEARS
UNTIL ASCERTAINED, OR UNTIL THE
FINAL DECREE IS ENTERED.

An interlocutory order having been heretofore entered under date of April 21, 1961, for underground water rights involved in the Proposed Determination herein, and it appearing that it is necessary that the amount of water to be withdrawn from underground sources during the year 1962 and for future years be fixed by the court, and to limit water users from the underground water basins to an amount not in excess of four acre-feet per acre of land awarded a water right under said Proposed Determination, and it further appearing that some water users during the year 1960, in cases of extraordinary hardship, were allowed to use an amount of water in excess of that provided for in the 1960 interlocutory order, conditioned on the agreement with the water users that any overage would be deducted the following three years by an amount equal to one-third of the excess used in the year 1960, now, therefore, it is

ORDERED

1. That during the year 1962 and until further ordered by order of the court, the use of water from the underground water basins involved herein shall be limited to four acre-feet per acre of land awarded a water right under said Proposed Determination.

2. That such water users who, during the year 1960, used an amount of water in excess of that provided for in the 1960 interlocutory order, shall be allowed to use such excess water during the years 1961, 1962 and 1963, provided that such excess water shall be deducted from the amount of water available to such users each year until the amount of such excess water has been fully repaid to the State.

3. That the State Engineer and the Water Commissioner are charged

with the duty of enforcing this order by shutting off of wells or by institution of contempt proceedings against persons violating this order.
