I apologize for the untimely response. Please realize that it is all our best interest to make sure the potential snags with your project are carefully addressed so as to not cause problems "downstream," if you will.

After our April 14 visit to the proposed site, it was determined that as per 73-3-29, State of Utah Code Annotated, 1953, (copy enclosed), a Permit Application to Alter a Natural Channel, would be necessary.

Mr. Kent Jones of our Distribution Section of the Division of Water Rights is responsible for the administration of the Permit Application. I have discussed your project and your time frame with him, and he has assured me that he will work expeditiously with Division of Wildlife, Central Division, who will need to be included in the review. Mr. Kendall Nelson, (of the Central Division of Wildlife), will work with us on a verbal basis rather than written to relate any possible concerns or recommendations that they may have.
