

ANNUAL REPORT OF THE DEEP CREEK AND MOSBY IRRIGATION SYSTEM

WATER YEAR 1985

I kept no totals on Mosby water. I took readings on weir's, but mostly I let the Stockholder use what water they wanted.

Spring came late. Deep Creek Water went unused, up to 20.00 S.F. per day until April 21, Water was turned into Huber Ditch. Had problems with the Bever damming up the water. Dave Murray got wet over more then he wanted to be.

May 5, Dave went on the mountain. Said there was water coming out of Juluis, but couldn't tell me how much. The Forest Service had both gate's locked. Dave had the only key.

When the gate was opened, I went on the Mt. could tell by the color of the snow and the beer cans every where Dave went and stopped, but he didn't stop at the weir.

There was 3.06 s.f.w. coming down the canal. (Please note the next page.) I went back and figured Mosby duty on every one but East Mosby & little water.

Please keep in mind, it cost right at \$20.00 every time I go to Juluis Park. Also, why charge Deep Creek Water if in fact some of it is Mosby Water.

Martin & Marvin Huber went on the Mountain the 16th. of May and turned water in Juluis. May 17th I had 22.00 c.f.w.

The weir at the Donhoe is Great. Saves time and milage. Easier to keep records also. It will be INDISPENABLE in a drought year when water is real tight.

The middle of August Mosby water got real low, and I opemed the pond. As in the past years, had an awful time getting water to the bottom of the Ditch. Bever Dams between Cooks and Huber headgate was backing up the water.

The Big rain strom on July 27th helped wet things up. Another rain in Sept. gave us more water then we could use. Lance Luck turned the Pond off on Sept. 19th and very little water was used after that.

When I see things like 20.00s.f.w. going on down the creek in April & May, and again in Sept. Sometimes in August when people are putting in crops and then in June & july they need the water so very much to even make a crop. And this year several of them on the lower end said they couldn't get the ground wet or couldn't keep it wet. I feel that regardless of the cost that a storage pond be built that will store Mosby & Deep Creek water. It can't help but benfit the company as a whole. It will also improve everyone's Deep Creek filings.

Raymond Murray's ditch washed out. I spent two days at his ditch while it was being backheed out. No mileage was charged for this.

For 7 days I read a 3 ft. weir as a 4 ft. weir. Marin & marvin. I went back on my record and changed the reading to a 3 ft. and refigured the duty and changed the Deep Creek record. Sorry about that.

Stockerholders under the Whiterocks canal. This is a real problem. The headgate sands up. The ditchrider for Whiterock won't deliver the water and if the stockholder takes it Mr. Perry charge's them for whiterocks water.

All in all the stockholder were very easy to work with. I would like to thank all of them for there help.

I spent 161.84 dollars on telephone call's. I put in for around \$28.00 and got paid for it. the rest I'll pay because it was long distance for all the stockholders to get ahold of me.
