Dear Lance:

Re: Deep Creek

On March 27, 1978, we held the Ashley Creek Distribution System Annual Meeting. I noted that Mosby Irrigation Company was not represented. I am enclosing a copy of the minutes for your information. I am also enclosing a copy of the financial statement.

Last March 29, 1977, I sent a letter to David Murray, pointing out several matters that must be attended to in order for Mosby Irrigation Company to conform with the agreement between Mosby Irrigation Company and Ashley Valley Water Users. I am enclosing a copy of this letter to bring you up to date on the matter.

As was pointed out in the annual meeting, several things must be done by your company in order to use water out of Ashley Creek Drainage this year. These are as follows:

1 - Your parshall flume or other measuring device must be leveled, both ways, and put in an operating condition. We may want to install a continuous recorder in order to better regulate this remote diversion.

2 - If your headgate needs to be locked, a key must be provided to the Commissioner.


3 - Adjustments must be made only by the Commissioner or his delegated Deputy. (I may wish to authorize you or a member of your board, to do this on your initial diversion. I will keep in contact with you concerning this point.)

4 - The canal, coming from Dry Fork Twin Lakes, must be broken before it reaches Blanchett Park Diversion Dam, allowing this water to go on down Dry Fork Creek. This canal picks up water that should go to Dry Fork.

The prospects for water are much more favorable than last year.

I trust you and your company will co-operate so that all parties concerned may have a fair and equitable water supply for the coming season.
