Dear Wallace:

RE: GEORGE CREEK DISTRIBUTION

In accordance with the meeting held at the Yost church on Tuesday, November 19, 1964, you are instructed to deliver water during the wintertime in accordance with the rights as established in the determination in such a manner that the flow in the West and East branches of George Creek reaches the last user on each before water can be diverted for stockwatering purposes in any ditch. When the flow exceeds the rights, you are to request direction from the company as to the delivery of their water. Their water is then to be delivered as they request it into all designated ditches. No water is to be diverted except as directed by the company.

This directive does not preclude the possibility of individuals on either branch of George Creek voluntarily giving up the requirement that water be delivered to them under the right schedule. If such person voluntarily agrees to a deletion this water is to then be divided as outlined above.
