Re: Release of Mar Grange
 Appointment of Varden Wilson

Dear Hal:

In the last few weeks, it has come to my attention that Mar Grange has been relieved of his responsibilities as the Water Commissioner on Huntington Creek. This action has caused considerable concern with this office because Mr. Grange is a State employee in this position. He is neither appointed or relieved of his responsibilities by the Irrigation Company. Therefore, according to our records, he is still the authorized agent of the State Engineer to administer the waters of Huntington Creek. In an effort to resolve this problem would you please submit in writing, the reasons why Mr. Grange was relieved of his responsibilities, and who was involved in making this decision, whether it was the Board of Directors or through a general meeting of the stockholders. In this letter, you should request that the State Engineer follow your recommendation to have Mr. Grange released from this position. The actual release will come directly from the State Engineer.

A second letter is also requested, recommending Mr. Varden Wilson to replace Mr. Grange as the Water Commissioner. This letter should also indicate by what authority Mr. Wilson was recommended. Again, it will be through action of the State Engineer that Mr. Wilson is appointed and bonded to perform the work as river commissioner. In each of these matters, please reference the dates of the meetings when these actions were taken. We will also need Mr. Wilson's complete name, mailing address, home phone number, and Social Security number in order to prepare the necessary bond. If the State Engineer concurs with your recommendation, Mr. Wilson will be so advised by the State Engineer.

If you have any questions concerning this request, please contact me at your earliest convenience. It is important that the matter be taken care of as soon as possible thereby avoiding any possibility of repercussions.
