Notice is hereby given that in accordance with Utah Code Annotated Section 73-5-1 (1989), a meeting of the water users of the above referenced creeks and representatives of the Utah Division of Water Rights will be held **Thursday June 26, 1997 at 6:00 p.m.** The meeting will be held in the **Auditorium, Department of Natural Resources Building, 1594 West North Temple, Salt Lake City, Utah.**

Ed Higbee, the current commissioner for these creeks is retiring. Mr. Higbee has been serving as commissioner by appointment from the Third Judicial District Court. The water commissioner for these creeks will now be appointed by the State Engineer.

The purpose of the meeting will be to discuss the organization and operation of distribution systems, the authority of the state engineer, the responsibilities of the water users, the authority and duties of the commissioner, the annual water user assessments, and the requirements regarding control structures and measuring devices. The State Engineer will appoint an interim commissioner for 1997 after consultation with the water users in attendance at this first meeting.

It is anticipated that this will be the first of several meetings which will be required before a permanent distribution system organization is established and a regular water commissioner is appointed.
