Dear Steve:

I have reviewed the pay requests on the Burnt Fork and the West Fork of the Beaver Creek systems. As per our records, \$600.00 was authorized for your salary under the Burnt Fork system while the West Fork of Beaver Creek was increased to \$700.00. We have added the additional \$100.00 to the billing. There is also an additional 10 miles mileage that you didn't include in your mileage totals that we are including. We are having one problem, however. While the Burnt Fork system has adequate funds to meet your pay request, the West Fork of Beaver Creek has a few large delinquencies which leaves a balance in the account less than the amount owed to you.

We are paying you the amount of money that we have in the account plus we are actively trying to contact the delinquent users to get the delinquent fees collected. You can help by making sure that the delinquent accounts are in the right name and that we are sending them to the right locations. As soon as the money is received we will pay you the amounts owed.

Would you please review the enclosed delinquency statement for accuracy and tell us who is actually using the water under the delinquent accounts. This will help us in collecting the late amounts due.

By state law, these assessments are required to be paid or the water use may be terminated until the payment is made. We will do what we can to get the money in. If you have any questions, please contact Richard Sexton or me at our Salt Lake office or Bob Leske in our Vernal office.
